Admission policy

- BTech Admission is done on the basis of an entrance examination (WBJEE) conducted by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB). All seats in government colleges of Engineering and Certamic Technology are filled based on the basis of merit in WBJEE and counselling conducted by WBJEEB.
- 2. If any seat is left vacant after the counselling of WBJEEB, Institute fills those vacant seats by decentalised counselling as per procedure formulated by the Higher Education department of Government of West Bengal.
- 3. BTech Admission in the 2nd year under Lateral Entry scheme, is done **on the basis of an entrance examination** (JELET) conducted by the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB). All seats of Lateral Entry in Government Colleges of Engineering and Certamic Technology are filled based on the basis of merit in JELET and counselling conducted by WBJEEB.
- 4. If any seat earmarked for Lateral Entry is left vacant after the counselling of WBJEEB, Institute fills those vacant seats by decentalised counselling as per procedure formulated by the Higher Education department of Government of West Bengal.
- 5. M.Tech Admission is done on the basis of an entrance examination (PGET) conducted by the Maulana Abul Kalam University of Technology (MAKAUT). All seats of M.Tech in Government Colleges of Engineering and Certamic Technology are filled based on the basis of merit in PGET and counselling conducted by MAKAUT.
- 6. If any seat of M.Tech is left vacant after the counselling of MAKAUT, Institute fills those vacant seats by decentalised counselling as per procedure formulated by the Higher Education department of Government of West Bengal.
- 7. The enrolment of Ph.D scholars are done as per UGC guidelines.
