Keeping in mind of the huge demand of the Web Technology course in industry it was resolved that normal Web Technology elective paper would be changed to 6th semester from 7th semester. It was also resolved that the advanced Web Technology course with Full Stack Java Development would be introduced in the 7th semester structure as elective with a laboratory paper of 3 hours with 1 credit. This extra 1 credit may be adjusted by reducing the CLA credit of 6th and 7th semester to 0.5 and 0.5 respectively instead of 1 credit each.	Discussion on the syllabus of Advanced Web Technology course was made in the departmental meeting and will be placed in the next BOS meeting for approval.
