Dutta had advised some changes in the detailed syllabus of the Optimisation Techniques [BS(IT)407].</p> <p>It was decided to reduce some lectures from non linear modules (such as PERT-CPM etc) and introduce a new module containing dynamic programming and non linear programming.</p> <p>2.2 : The syllabus of Cryptography and Network Security was modified as per previous BOS and was proposed to email the revised syllabus to Prof. A. Bagchi who could not attend the meeting. It was suggested by the board members that 'expert system' may be excluded as it is a part of AI syllabus or it may be renamed as 'Application of expert system in Network Security'. It was also suggested that the no. of lecture hours should be at least 40 hours instead of 36 hrs.</p> <p>2.3: It was advised by the board members to increase the no. of lecture hours of 'GIS & Remote Sensing ' to 40hrs.</p>	<p>Against agenda no. 2</p> <p>As per suggestions of the external board members, the syllabi for Optimisation Techniques [BS(IT)407], Cryptography and Network Security [PE(IT)804C] and GIS & Remote Sensing [OE(IT)803D] were modified.</p> <p>The syllabus of Cryptography and Network Security was mailed to Prof. A. Bagchi for his valuable suggestions.</p>
