



BENEVOLENCE FUND

Government College of Engineering and Ceramic Technology Alumni Association

Rules and regulations on formation and execution:

<u>Origin</u>: The faculty/staff and the members of the Alumni Association of the College have a concern on the social responsibility for helping the needy personnel or their family members those who are/were associated to the college, present and former students, faculty, staff and alumni members. On this ground the Alumni Association proposes to create a "Benevolence Fund" for the needy person/ members. The issue was proposed and widely accepted in the 6th General Body Meeting held on the 25th April 2021 and creation of such 'Fund' was urgently felt for formal execution through a Committee termed as "Benevolence Committee". The members of the newly formed committee are mentioned below.

Eligibility of beneficiary: The benefit of such fund will be given to person/s related and associated to the College and its activities or that of the Association, and their family members (normally spouse and/or ward, in case of absence of the beneficiary) to bear the medical expenses, education of the ward or for the family needs in the case of death of the concerned person. Any other case of such exigency will also be dealt by this benevolent committee.

<u>Modality of execution</u>: The needy personnel/family member should appeal to the Association via Executive committee detailing the cause and the need describing the family status, preferably with the family income and other supporting document/s for consideration. The appeal will be considered by the benevolence committee and forward to the approving authority for the disbursement of fund.

<u>Modus operandi for reimbursement</u>: The onus of the benevolence committee is to consider the gravity of the need based on the appeal made by the person concerned and gathering relevant information and recommend the EC to take necessary action. On review of the appeal, benevolence committee will put in its comments within seven days to Executive Committee.

The applicant has to submit an application in a prescribed format to be provided by GCECT Association along with supporting details for consideration.

<u>Quantity of benefits</u>: The fund will be raised by the donations available from the College staff and Alumni members, to be informed by the executive committee as and when required. Any other personnel interested to help may contribute to the fund. In the case of poor balance available in the fund, the Executive Committee will decide on transfer of a part of the amount, as convenient, from the association account to the Benevolence fund.

A separate bank account will be opened for creation of the benevolence fund as aforesaid, the operation of which will be done by the existing signatories of the Alumni association. All donations should be deposited

to the benevolence account and disbursement of the fund to the beneficiary should be done from the same account by check/demand draft drawn in favor of the beneficiary or by digital transfer and maintain a record of the total fund available for disbursement. The transactions are auditable.

The amount to be disbursed to the needy applicant in a financial year will depend on the recommendation of the benevolence committee and the executive committee. More applications from different persons/beneficiaries can be considered for help, depending on the availability of the fund.

<u>Approving authority</u>: The application for support after recommendations of the benevolence committee will be transmitted to the Executive committee through Secretary for formal approval. Final approval for disbursement of the fund to the beneficiary will be under purview of the President, Vice Presidents and Secretary of the EC.

<u>Tenure of Committee</u>: Until such work for execution is prevented for any valid reason, the tenure of the Benevolence committee is co-terminus with the Executive committee and a new such committee will be formed for execution with formation of the new Executive Committee. This new committee will function with effect from 1st May 2021. The committee shall have the power to accommodate any other member, if required.

<u>Income tax</u>: The donations received from the doners will not be eligible under 80G act of Indian Income Tax rules unless permissions are obtained from the pertinent authority by the association. Similarly, the disbursed amount will also follow the income tax rules.

<u>Any other</u>: The Committee reserves the right to consider or reject any application with legitimate rules and reasons, as necessary.
